ADVANCED DENTAL EDUCATION PROGRAM AT USC

Applications for advanced dental education programs are being accepted until November, 1969, by the University of Southern California School of Dentistry for the 1970 terms.

Advanced programs will be offered in endodontics, oral surgery, orthodontics, pedodontics, periodontics, and prosthodontics. Applicants are admitted to the programs in dentistry through the USC Graduate School and may pursue either a certificate program leading to eligibility by examination by a national certifying board or a master's degree in basic sciences concomitant with the specialty.

Through a grant from the United States Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, two postdoctoral fellowships in pedodontics are available for the 1970-1971 academic year. The emphasis under this grant is directed toward the special care of handicapped and chronically ill children.
